Miss Fairest of the Fair Rules

1. Contestants must be a resident of West Tennessee and may not represent more than one fair in any given year.
2. Contest will be for ladies aged 17-20 years. Contestant must not reach her 21st birthday on or before December 31, 2025. Contestant must compete in their age division based on date of the pageant.
3. Contestant must be single, never married, and have no children.
4. Contestants must model in pageant wear and attire **must be floor length**.
5. No applications will be accepted for entry if the contestant has ever competed in the State Fairest of the Fair pageant.
6. Entries **WILL NOT** be accepted at the door on the day of the pageant contest.
7. All Pageant Contests will be held in the air-conditioned Williams Auditorium at Chester County Middle School. Contestants are required to arrive by 8:30 a.m.
8. Judging will be based on attractiveness and poise (50%), interview (25%) and personality (25%).
*The decision of the judges is final. Each pageant court will consist of a Queen and four alternates.
9. Each contestant must be accompanied by a parent or guardian and only one person is allowed backstage with the contestant. Parent or guardian must be seated prior to pageant beginning.
*There will be no exceptions due to state safety guidelines.
10. There will be no rehearsal prior to the pageant.
11. **Videoing IS NOT allowed during any of the pageant contests.**
12. A master list of contestants will be at the **main entrance only**, allowing the contestant and **one other person** to enter the auditorium at no cost. **Chaperone must enter with the contestant**. All others must pay admission; voucher will be provided guaranteeing admission to the fairgrounds located on Fourth Street.
13. Contestant crowned 2025 Miss Fairest of the Fair will be asked to stay throughout the remainder of the day to assist with crowning in younger age categories.

Statement & Royalty Agreement

As a contestant in the 2025 West Tennessee State Miss Fairest of the Fair, I understand and agree to the following statements:

- I have neither participated in the State Fairest of the Fair nor have I won another pageant that would make me ineligible for the 2025 State Fairest of the Fair.
- I am now and always have been a female. I am single, never married, and have no children.
- As the 2025 Queen, I will be the official hostess at all events at the West Tennessee State Fair the remaining days of the fair.
- I will refrain from any conduct that would result in embarrassment to my title; such as, but not limited to:
 - Use of alcoholic beverages or other controlled substances.
 - Behavior that results in disciplinary action by school officials; or arrest, indictment, or conviction for a crime against any municipality, state, or the United States.
 - Public fighting or cursing.
 - Pregnancy and/or marriage.
- If I am found to have participated in any misconduct, I shall voluntarily surrender my title.
- Minimum 20 hours community service while wearing your title sash. This can be done in any county in West Tennessee. Please send description of community service with pictures.
 - West Tennessee State Fair's Fairest of the Fair Queen will be a representative at the Tennessee's State Fairest of the Fair contest in Murfreesboro held January 2026.

I hereby grant the West Tennessee State Fair permission to use my photograph in any or all publications and in any and all other media as decided by the West Tennessee State Fair Board of Pageant Committee. I will make no monetary or other claim against West Tennessee State Fair, its Board Members, Directors, or nay others involved in the fair for the use of information and photographs.
