## **Demolition Derby Rules**

1. All participants must be 18 years of age or over.
2. All cars must be 1980 model or newer to run.
3. All glass, Chrome, and other moldings must be removed.
4. Battery must be moved to the front passenger floor and secured.
5. Gas tank must be in the rear seat location and secured.
6. Max. tire size is 16 inches with 5 hole bolt pattern. No solid tires.
7. Only welding allowed is the driver's door and bumper mounts.
8. No frame seam welding.
9. Must have original body mounts. All thread max 5/8 inch 4 places through hood and trunk. Other doors are to be chained or wired shut. If you have plastic inner wells you may add a 4inch X 4inch plate to front fenders for hood bolts.
10. Bumpers may be chained, but if chained to the hood, this will count as one of your hood fasteners.
11. Cages are allowed inside the car. No more than 6 inches behind the driver's seat on 2 door car, and no more than 8 inches past driver's seat on 4 door cars. Must be at least 10 inches off the floor.
12. No suspension changes. 2 Spacers are allowed on front springs. No welding down A-Arms. Rear springs can be wired or small chained. No chaining of humps.
13. No chaining frame to body.
14. Transmission coolers and or fans will be allowed. They must be secured.
15. Bumpers may be changed. No aftermarket. Must be factory. No adding metal. Clean welds to shock mounts.
16. No imperial bumpers or truck bumpers.
17. No extra body bolts.
18. No prebending of frames. Frame may be cut for bending, but no welding of frame. No tucking of trunk lids.
19. No motor protectors or distributor protectors.
20. All cars will be inspected. It will be the decision of the inspector and inspectors call is final.
